Dinghy Class: Your child will be brought to you at the entrance to the early years area.

Skiff Class: An adult should collect their child from the class teacher at the main school entrance.

Lugger Class: Children should wait at the main school entrance until they see an adult to collect them. If you want your child to meet you someone where else (at the side gate for example, please make sure the class teacher knows about this arrangement).

Schooner Class: Children can meet their responsible adult somewhere on the school site.

We have made it clear to all the children that if they are not collected at the arranged place, they should return to the main entrance and wait inside to be collected. If your child is being collected by someone different to routine i.e. they are going home with a friend or an unfamiliar relative, please can you inform the school office in good time. In the New Year, we will be installing a second fence at the side gate: we will let you know more about how we expect it to be used when it is installed.

We would like to thank Mr Corti for very kindly donating our lovely big **Christmas Tree** this year for the main reception. The children have each made a decoration and the tree is looking really fantastic now all decorated.
