**Skiff Class** have had a fantastic term exploring the question 'Animals: Threatened or Thriving'?

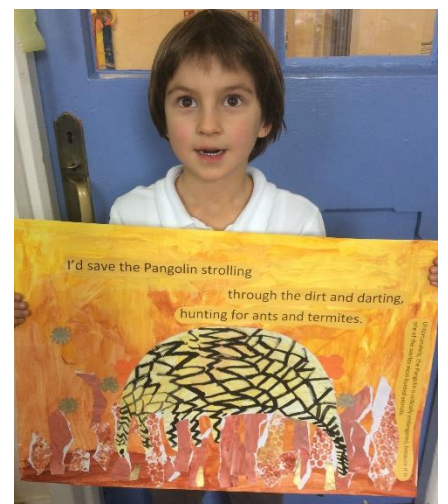


Their learning culminated in a beautiful book in which each child created a stunning page of collage and art. The text describes the animal and explains why they are endangered.
